

sugared A comprehensive Report on English Language Campus

After the war, rehabilitation and restoration were the words that occupied the minds of the people. The people were desperate to pick up the bits and pieces of their lives shattered by the brutal war.

In this war of attrition, education was also a casualty. Many students lost the opportunities of precious gift of their journey of education.

It was revealed that Vanni was the least performing district in education especially in English.

The local Catholic Church in Vanni began to brainstorm how to improve the English educational level in Vanni.

With this intent many meetings were organized and many counsels were sought from various sources. Rev. Fr. A. J. Yavis, then the dean of Kilinochchi District, chaired and facilitated the meetings of priests and others.

Finally it was decided to commence an English Teacher Training Programme for the adults from the rural areas with the basic OL qualification.

In the year 2013, suitable candidates were recruited from the rural villages and the Teaching Training Programme took off at 146 Kanahambikaikulam, Kilinochchi just in front of the Lebara Library.

Fr. Sylvester, OMI, then the director of Annai Illam negotiated with an individual who claimed ownership for the land and the house (which is now strongly disputed) located just in front of the Library to provide grant residence to the students. A formal contract was signed for ten years. The Oblates at the Lebara Library released a classroom for our purpose and promised to do so for the future.

On June 6th 2013, Very Rev. Fr. Paul Natchethiram, the Provincial of the Oblates of Mary Immaculate, of officially blessed the place and opened the programme.

We had a formal programme with practical training along with the computer skills for the candidates. Many applied and we could take only 30 students just to have a quality teaching and classroom experience. Some innovate methods of teaching were introduced and that benefitted the students very much.

We had many helpers to conduct the programme. One such helper was late Mr. Muththulingam who passed into eternity owing to his heart illness.

Bishop Thomas Savundaranayagam, the former Bishop of Jaffna endorsed the programme and accepted to be the Patron and signed the certificates of graduation. He paid a visit to the place and blessed the staff and the students.

At the end of the second year, we experienced a period of draught and the water was in short supply. We were forced to buy water for enormous amount from outside to care for our daily needs.

The Oblates who promised to help us with classroom changed their mind too as they were getting more requests for the use of the classrooms from the various non-governmental institutions with financial remuneration.

So we were forced to find a temporary classroom at 146 Kanakambihaikulam and began to conduct classes in our own place itself.

The disputed house owner who formally signed a contract with us for ten years refused to honour his promise and caused much stress. The doubt as to the ownership was confirmed.

It was at this time, Mr. S. Thevathasan offered his 3 acres of land with coconut plantations and with great water resources. In his generosity he put up a suitable building for us to run this programme.

In the month of May, 2017 we moved to the new site at Punnaineeravi, Viswamadhu. This new place enjoys a great learning environment. It is so green and slushy. We continued the English Teacher Training Programme and we had completed the training for the 6th batch. However it has now become more challenging to recruit candidates for this programme.

The ELC wanted to expand its services to the school children. We designed a programme called 'A 'n OL for Schoolers'. The purpose of this programme is to make the children to pass the OL exam in English possibly with a good grade.

The first batch of students was selected from Pappamoddai to Poonakary when they completed their Grade 6. They are expected to come to the ELC on the fourth weekend of every month and to attend an English Camp during the term holidays.

Then we started another Batch of students from Paranthan to Mullaithivu, They are to come to the ELC on the second weekend of every month.

We provide them hospitality free of charge along with the bus fare to return home after each programme. There is a great appreciation from their respective schools and the principals are very supportive of these two programmes. In these two programmes we have over 100 children.

We like to lead them all the way to their OL exam. Once the Batch One faces the exam, we will recruit fresh batch from grade 6 and plan to follow the same routine.

After the opening of the Library - Global Advanced Frontiers Joint Library - we plan to invite the students in the neighbourhood to come for an 'After School Programme' with the game of one hour from 4:00 pm and two hours of revision of all the lessons of the day at the school.

From the month of February, we plan to have a 'Play School for Pre-Schoolers'. The children who attend the preschools in the neighbourhood will be invited to the ELC for 90 minutes programme, for three days a week and 100 days a year. During this programme, children can play at the TT park and they will be taught English to prepare them to begin their Grade One with hope and confidence. Introducing them to English at an early age will be of great asset. The children who attend the preschool for Pre-Schoolers'. The preschoolers' pres

There is another application for Ability Building courses to be conducted by a team of qualified people both from Colombo and here. These courses are targeting the young adults who like to earn some money by bard ow familiarising themselves with certain skills in some particular fields.

Another huge development on this campus is building of an English Library with the Beauties of Meadows which enshrines the names of the Priests who were slain during the war from 1994 to 2009. These names cannot be and should not be forgotten.

The primary purpose of this library is to impart English Education and to maintain the historical heritages of our beautiful country with the gift of diversity of a bistuo most muomis suomions for ratew yard of based and



English is a world language. In the modern world one needs to know English to communicate with the world. Once you leave Colombo airport, you cannot manage with the local languages of the country.


Besides, the language of English is needed for employment. If we want to avail ourselves of the technological advancements, we need to master the English Language.


Finally, I like to tell the priests and religious to visit this place and encourage the people to avail themselves of the opportunities provided by this English Language Campus and the Library.


HasSt-Antony Become less Powerful?

A young university graduate approached me with a huge doubt in his heart after the Easter Bombings on 21/4 at the shrine of Saint Antony, Kochchikadai, Colombo. He began to tell me: "My dad is now retired and spends much of his time on bed. His hobby is to watch the television. After watching the horrific scenes of bombings in Colombo and Batticaloa, a strong question arose in his heart. Why did Saint Antony permit such a tragedy in his own church? He is considered a very powerful saint in the church. Could he not have stopped perpetrator from detonating the bomb? Using all his powers, could he not have twisted his arm and thrown him out of the church?"

I told the young graduate that it was easy on the part of his dad to think in the way he thought, but it must be different thinking on the young man as he had passed through the portals of the university.

Then we sat down to have a discourse on this serious matter. The discourse borders onto Philosophical Anthropology which enunciates that every being is endowed with freedom. Freedom and Knowledge are two essential components of every human being. It is this freedom that makes human being a moral being. Human freedom is the foundation for the morality that is enshrined in every man and woman. As long as every man and woman is a moral being, he and she should be free beings.

Further, no human being can commit a mortal sin by chance. In the same way, nobody can perform a virtuous act by mistake. Full knowledge and freedom are required for any of the two.


